- In addition to the Club Teams, we will attempt to form up to three Open Teams.
- Our fee schedule has been modified:
  - Open Team fees are now \$800 to cover the cost of extra practice dates.
  - Club Team and Developmental Program Fees will stay at \$450/\$350 respectively.
  - Late fees will be assessed for late tryout registration and late Program fees.

### Tryout Schedule

**Open Team Tryouts - November 20 at Masconomet HS** from 8:00AM to 12:00PM.

- Three teams (U16, U17 and U18) may be selected depending on the number of players attending tryouts.
- Open tryouts will continue on November 25 at the Beverly YMCA (8-10PM), November 27 at Masco (8AM-12PM), and again on December 1 at the Beverly YMCA.
- Team selection will be finalized by the December 4 practice at Masco.
- Open teams will practice every Sunday from 11:00AM to 1:00PM at Masco and every Thursday from 8:00 - 10:00 PM at the Beverly YMCA.
- Open team competition includes the Winterfest tournament in Hartford, CT (January 13-16), NERVA Qualifiers in Derry, NH (February 4-5 or 11 - 12), and five regular season tournaments.
- A second travel tournament will be considered (Albany, Baltimore, or Florida) but will involve extra fees.

**Club Team Tryouts - December 4 and 11 at Masconomet HS.**

- 15 and Under: 8:00 AM - 11:00 AM
- 18 and Under: 10:30 AM - 12:00 noon
- Extra tryout session for U16 and U18 will be held at our Danvers facility on December 9 (U18) and December 16 (U16).
- Initial team selection will be done on December 18. Final team selection will be completed by the first practice on January 8.
- If a team decides to attend the Winterfest tournament in Hartford, CT (January 13-16) there will be an extra \$100 entry fee cost and players are responsible for their own hotel arrangements.

## North Shore Developmental Program

If your volleyball skills are not developed well enough for the Club Team competition - NSJVB also offers a Developmental Program that runs every Sunday AM from December 4, 2011 to May 6, 2012, at the Danvers facility. The Developmental Program, established in 2006, has been very successful for both athletes new to the sport as well as players needing additional skill training before trying out for the Club Team level. Players will receive intensive skill training in all aspects of competitive volleyball play, and will receive evaluations of their skills at regular intervals over the season.

**Directions to Masconomet Regional High School:** Take I-95N to Endicott Street (Exit 51) in Topsfield, MA. Turn right (East) at top of ramp and the High School is the first group of buildings to the East of I-95. Go past the front of the school and turn right into the last entrance road to the school. The field house is at the end of the parking lot.

**Directions to Danvers Industrial Park:**

From the South – Take Route 1 north to the Rt 62 exit heading west toward Middleton. Immediately go back up on Route 1 heading south. Go approximately ½ mile and take the first exit into the Danvers Industrial Park. Proceed straight across a crossroad and head between the two warehouses directly in front of you. The gym is at the back of the building on the right. The sign on the building says Futbol Sportsplex. The entrance door is on the left at the unloading dock.

From the North – Take Rt 1 south. After passing the Rt 62 exits, go approximately ½ mile and take the first exit into the Danvers Industrial Park. Proceed straight across a crossroad and head between the two warehouses directly in front of you. The gym is at the back of the building on the right. The sign on the building says Futbol Sportsplex. The entrance door is on the left at the unloading dock.
